Note: If you are not a member of US Ski & Snowboard, the camp staff will assist you in either joining (recommended if you are planning to go to additional masters races) or obtaining a one-day short-term license.

#### **Recommended Lodging:**



Silver Run has reserved a room block: "Upper Level Room" (2 queens or 1 king), \$89/night + tax, at The Yodeler Motel, <u>www.yodelermotel.com</u>, 1-866-446-1435. Lower level rooms are also available at \$65/night + tax.

The Yodeler is located near the bottom of the ski area access road and an easy walk into the heart of Red Lodge. The motel has complimentary ski tuning benches and vices. Note: The room block will be released on November 3, 2018.

#### Lift Tickets:

Red Lodge Mountain offers discounted multi-day lift tickets which can be purchased at the ticket window or even cheaper on-line (<u>www.redlodgemountain.com</u>). Estimated cost for a 5-day lift ticket based on 2017-18 rates:
