SCHEDULE:

Sat, Sep 9: Depart North America and Europe for Bariloche, Argentina.

Sun, Sep 10: Arrive in Bariloche. Transfer to hotel.

Mon, Sep 11: Acclimatization day - Free skiing and drills on slalom skis with coaches.

Tue, Sep 12: Slalom training (morning + afternoon sessions).

Wed, Sep 13: Slalom training (morning). Afternoon off.

Thu, Sep 14: Free skiing drills on GS skis (morning); GS training (afternoon).

Fri, Sep 15: GS training (morning + afternoon sessions).

Sat, Sep 16: SG training.

Sun, Sep 17: FIS Masters Cup - 2xSG (2nd SG counts as a stand-alone race and for the Alpine Combined)

Mon, Sep 18: FIS Masters Cup – SL/AC (1st run counts for the Alpine Combined. $2^{nd} + 3^{rd}$ runs = SL race)

Tue, Sep 19: FIS Masters Cup - 2xGS (2 one-run GS's).

Wed, Sep 20: Depart Bariloche.

The, Sep 21: Arrive home.

Note: You must be a member of your country's national governing body for alpine ski racing, e.g. US Ski and Snowboard, and hold an FIS Masters license to compete.

If you are traveling alone but wish to share a room, we will try to match you with another athlete in the camp. If no one is available to share a room with you, your registration will convert to single occupancy with the appropriate balance due.

If you are over age 70, deduct \$300 from whatever package you choose. Skiers ages 70+ ski free at Catedral-Bariloche.

AIR TRAVEL

Athletes arrange their own round-trip travel to Bariloche (BRC).

Sep 10: To take the camp's private bus to the Club Hotel Catedral, plan to arrive at BRC no later than 1:00pm. Sep 20: To take the camp's private bus from the Club Hotel Catedral to BRC, plan to depart BRC no earlier than 10:20am.

If you book an itinerary that does not match up with the camp's ground transportation schedule, there is no refund, and you are responsible for reserving and paying for your own ground transportation.

IMPORTANT! This year, Aerolineas Argentinas offers two round-trip flights on the camp's travel dates from Buenos Aires-EZE to BRC. Otherwise, you must change airports from the international airport (EZE) to the domestic airport (AEP).

The camp has pre-purchased 15 round-trip plane tickets for athletes on the EZE-BRC / BRC-EZE flights, first-come first served, for the special group rate of US\$350 per person:
